Featured works include Schoenberg's *Pierrot Lunaire*, fully staged and costumed; major works of Louis Andriessen and George Crumb; Steve Reich's *Music for 18 Musicians*; and the world premiere of Steven Mackey's *Slide* – a concert-length music/theater piece.
