General Information, Terms, and Conditions

Confirmation. As soon as we receive your reservation deposit, we will send you a written receipt. When available, we will also send you a more detailed schedule of activities.

Deposit payments. We require a deposit of \$500 per person to confirm your trip reservation. This may be paid with a Visa, MasterCard, or personal check. Reservations made after May 1, 2008, require full payment at the time of booking.

Balance payments. The balance of the trip price (including any single supplement) is due no later than May 1, 2008, payable by check or credit card. If you pay your deposit by credit card, we will assume that you would like your balance also paid by credit card and we will charge your balance due on May 1 unless you instruct us otherwise in writing. If the balance is not paid when due, we reserve the right to regard your reservation as cancelled.

Cancellation & refunds. If you cancel your reservation prior to May 1, 2008, we will refund one-half of your deposit, \$250 per person. We will treat the balance as a contribution to San Francisco Contemporary Music Players. If you wish to cancel your reservation after May 1, 2008, we will refund your payments, less a \$500 deduction per person, only if the opera trip is sold out and we are able to resell your space. In such event, we would treat the \$500 balance retained as a contribution to San Francisco Contemporary Music Players.

Arrival and departure. The trip begins and ends at the Inn on the Alameda (303 E. Alameda, Santa Fe, New Mexico, 87501), a very comfortable and conveniently located hotel. We will arrange for a van to transport you from the Albuquerque airport to the Inn and return to the Albuquerque airport if your flights arrive and depart within the times listed on the detailed schedule of activities to come. If not, you will need to make your own arrangements to get from the airport to the Inn.

Accommodations. We have made a group booking of rooms at the Inn on the Alameda for the 3 nights from Thursday, July 24, to Sunday, July 27. The trip price is based on two people per room. If you are traveling alone we will be happy to help you find a roommate of the same gender, or you can choose to room alone, paying the single supplement of \$450. If you wish to extend your stay, either before or after the tour, you should contact the Inn directly at 1-800-

Insurance. We strongly urge you to consider trip insurance.

Trip price includes: Opera tickets, Rooms at the Inn (double occupancy), continental breakfast each morning, afternoon wine and cheese at the Inn, welcome dinner, two preview dinners at the Opera buffet, previews and discussions with Music Director David Milnes, private tours and discussions at the Opera, guided tour of a museum, visit to the home of a private art collector, local transportation, and airport transfers as scheduled.

Trip price does not include. Airfare, single supplement, personal expenses including alcoholic beverages, extended stays.
